

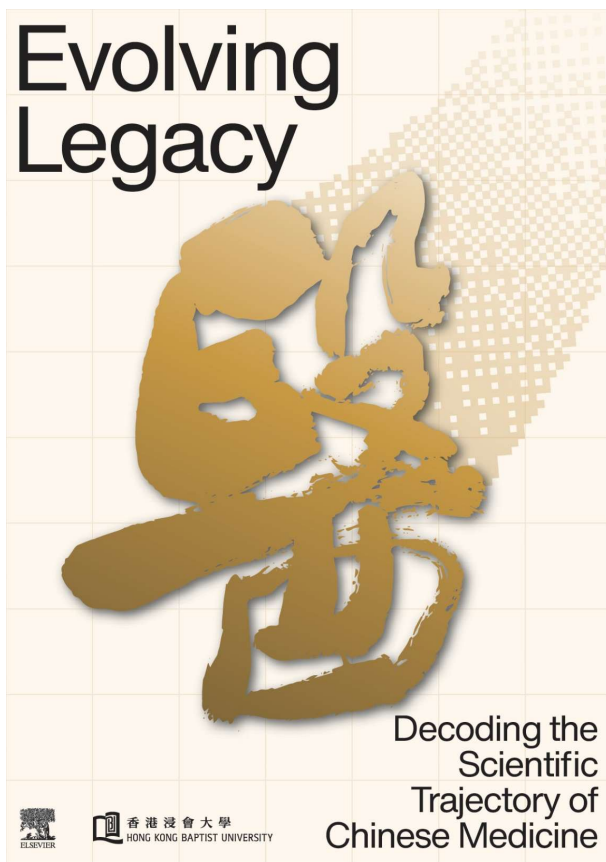

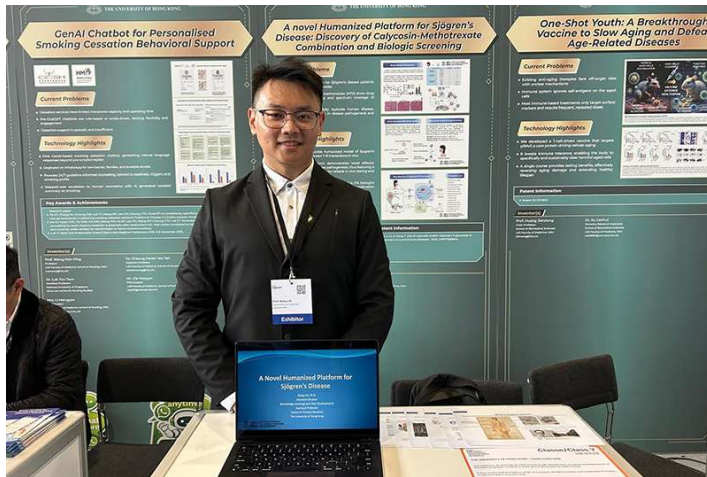
Thirteen SCM Scholars in total listed among the **World's Top 2% Most-Cited Scientists in 2025** by Stanford University.
